### Computer Literacy

Print out the document ESLRs 2010-2011 (in Assignments and Documents folder). Turn it over, and write your name, class period, and today's date at the top of the document, then complete your choice of TWO of the following possible assignments. (You may use another sheet of paper if needed.)

Possible Assignments:

1. Write down the words from the ESLRs definitions that you do not understand and look up their definitions, then write the definitions down next to the words.

3. Answer the following question in a well-crafted paragraph: What does it mean to produce quality work?
4. Write a short (two or three paragraph) story showing how the main character shows respect for diverse cultures in a school situation.
5. Describe a time when you used technology to complement your subject area knowledge, for example, when you had a project to do for a core class like English, Math, or History.
6. Draw a picture of yourself contributing as a leader in your community. What would this look like? (more than stick figures, please...)
