

Portfolio Requirements
11th & 12th Grade Students
Journalism

The portfolio requirements for Journalism, 11th and 12th grade students, are as follows:

- Print out three of your best written or artistic pieces to put in your portfolio. Put them in the White portfolio binder you get in Advisory, but check them off with me (so I can give you a grade) before you head out the door to put them in the binder.
- Include a printout of the Monthly Ponder that contains one of your articles. Again, put in White portfolio binder, show to me beforehand.
- Reflection: Write ONE reflection for whole portfolio. Reflect on a) your development as a journalist over the year; b) the process of creating a student newspaper; and c) the Expected Schoolwide Learning Results (ESLRs) that relate to your development as a journalist and the process of creating a student newspaper. Print two copies of this, one to put in your binder with the work and one to hand in to me on Friday, June 9th.
